

Village Board Work Session
December 17, 2012
7:00 p.m.

Mayor Roddey introduced Rebecca Lafargue, a member of the Planning Board, and explained that the evening's agenda would be a conversation about sidewalks.

The Board reviewed a letter from Lanc & Tully providing an overview of the scope of services and associated costs for the installation and replacement of sidewalks along Greenwich Avenue within the village.

Following discussion, the Board concluded that although several areas in the village could benefit from sidewalks, the first dispersal of sidewalk funding would go towards Greenwich Avenue.

The Board reviewed a proposal from Lanc & Tully for preparing right-of-way boundaries and/or parcel boundaries along the north side of NYS Route 207, (Greenwich Avenue), for approximately 500 feet just west of Clowes Avenue.

On a motion by Trustee Stewart, seconded by Trustee Smith, the Mayor is hereby authorized to sign a proposal from Lanc & Tully Engineering and Surveying, P.C., to perform a Right-of-Way Survey for a fee of \$1,600.00 and a Topographic Survey for a fee of \$2,800.00 for the Greenwich Avenue Sidewalks project.
