

Village Board Work Session
August 16, 2010

Members present: Mayor Higgins, Trustees Char, Mattheus, Roddey, and Stewart.

Jeff Albanese, Real Estate Manager for Quick Chek, and Jeffrey Martell, PE, of Bohler Engineering, addressed the Board with plans for a Quick Chek convenience store to be located in Goshen.

The proposal would develop approximately two acres of a seven acre parcel located off North Connector Road.

Ms. Rosa Gurny appeared before the Board to discuss her recent letter regarding a "Pay It Forward" event.
