Mr. Wieslaw Kolakowski, owner of an apartment building at 81 South Street, addressed the Board about the issue of garbage pick up. Mr. Kolakowski noted that his building contains six apartments, but that he would prefer to use garbage cans rather than the current dumpster, which is damaging his blacktop.

Mayor Higgins informed Mr. Kolakowski that the Board will get back to him, following discussion with the Village Attorney.

Trustee Roddey reported on his recent "Energy Efficiency and Conservation Incentive Financing" grant applications to the Orange County Department of Planning.

Trustee Mattheus noted that she and Superintendent Nuzzolese had requested, and expected to receive funding in the amount of \$3,000 from the O. C. Water Authority for the recently completed leak detection study.

Trustee Mattheus advised that she and Maureen Quattrini are looking into a new "welcome" sign, and that they will seek assistance with funding from the Bicentennial Committee.
