The Village of Goshen Police Department would like to remind motorists that school has opened and to be aware of children walking to and from school.

School speed zones are in effect from 7am to 6pm, daily. Patrols will be monitoring these zones and have zero tolerance for violators.

Motorists must obey the directions of school crossing guards and patrols will be monitoring these areas for compliance. School crossings are at the intersection of Scotchtown Ave. and McNally St., from 8am to 8:45am and 3pm to 3:45pm, and at the intersection of North Church St. and Lincoln Ave., from 2:20pm to 3pm, daily.
