

STATE OF EMERGENCY DECLARATION

A STATE OF EMERGENCY IS HEREBY DECLARED IN THE VILLAGE OF GOSHEN EFFECTIVE MARCH 18, 2020 AT 9:00AM.

WHEREAS, on March 7, 2020 the New York State Governor declared a State-wide disaster emergency as a result of the disease outbreak of the coronavirus (COVID-19) and;

WHEREAS, in the state-wide emergency declaration, the Governor stated that both travel-related cases and community contact transmission of COVID-19 have been documented in New York State and more are expected to continue; and

WHEREAS, the spread of the COVID-19 virus threatens the public safety; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Goshen must take all appropriate and necessary measures to address the threat that COVID-19 poses to the health and welfare of its residents and those who work and/or visit the Village;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, MICHAEL NUZZOLESE, as Chief Executive Officer of the Village of Goshen, do hereby exercise the authority given me under Section 24 of the New York State *Executive Law*, to preserve the public safety and hereby render all required and available assistance vital to the security, well-being and health of the citizens of the Village of Goshen.

I hereby direct all departments and agencies of the Village of Goshen to take whatever steps are necessary to protect life and property, public infrastructure and provide such emergency assistance deemed necessary.

THIS STATE OF EMERGENCY WILL REMAIN IN EFFECT FOR THIRTY (30) DAYS OR UNTIL RESCINDED BY A SUBSEQUENT ORDER.
