

**VILLAGE OF GOSHEN, NEW YORK
DECLARATION OF LOCAL STATE OF
EMERGENCY**

EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 12 OF 2020

I, **Michael Nuzzolese**, duly elected Mayor of the Village of Goshen, New York, do hereby declare as an **EXECUTIVE ORDER** the following:

WHEREAS, I have heretofore declared a State of Emergency to exist in the Village of Goshen and have issued Executive Orders numbered 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10 and 11 pursuant to the authority vested in me by New York State Executive Law § 24;

WHEREAS, the said State of Emergency remains in effect and the conditions resulting in the imposition of the State of Emergency and requiring issuance of the aforementioned Executive Orders remains necessary;

NOW, THEREFORE, as a result of the foregoing, the State of Emergency issued on March 18, 2020 and re-issued on April 18, 2020 and re-issued on May 18, 2020 remains in effect until June 18, 2020 and the terms, provisions and conditions of Executive Order #11 are hereby reaffirmed and continued by this Executive Order #12 of 2020.

All Village of Goshen local law or Code provisions that are contrary to the above are hereby suspended to the extent necessary, and all other Village of Goshen local law or Code provisions that may prevent, hinder, or delay necessary action in coping with this emergency are also suspended, but only to the minimum deviation extent necessary.

This executive order shall take effect as noted above, at 9:00 a.m. on June 1, 2020, and pursuant to New York Executive Law § 24, shall be published as soon as practicable in a newspaper of general circulation in the area and transmitted to the radio and television media for publication and broadcast.

THIS EXECUTIVE ORDER WILL REMAIN IN EFFECT FOR FIVE (5) DAYS OR UNTIL RESCINDED BY A SUBSEQUENT ORDER.
