



Village of Goshen *Trash and Recycling Program*

Background:

The Village of Goshen has purchased trash and recycling bins (carts) for the residents of the Village as part of an Environmental Benefits Project. The design of the new carts will help prevent rain water from mixing with the trash, reduce potential spilling, and prevent wildlife from entering and spreading trash. The carts have built-in wheels and handle to help residents moving the carts to the curb.

Carts:

The carts are the property of the Village of Goshen, please do not damage, paint, or modify the carts.

Trash Cart Color = Green

Recycling Cart Color = Blue

Pickup Schedule:

Pickup schedule for the trash and recycling remains the same. Refer to the Village of Goshen's website for the collection schedule: www.villageofgoshen-ny.gov

Cart Placement For Pickup:

Carts must be placed at or within 3 feet of the curb or street no later than 7:00 AM on the day of collection.

Items That Are Required To Be Recycled:

Recycling is required in accordance with Village of Goshen Law. All materials to be recycled should be empty and clean. Items that may be recycled are listed below.

Paper – newspaper, junk mail, computer paper, corrugated cardboard, soft-cover books, phone books, milk/juice cartons

Plastic – containers marked #1 through #7

Metal – cans, empty aerosol cans, aluminum cans, aluminum foil

Glass – green, clear, brown

Items That Cannot Be Recycled:

- Soiled paper goods, paper cups, tissues, napkins, plastic bags, pots, pans, cookware, ceramic or glass plates or cups, containers that held toxic substances, styrofoam, and toys.

Items That Cannot Be Placed In Trash:

- Hazardous materials or substances, such as poisons, acids, caustics, infected materials or explosives.
- Construction or demolition debris such as plaster, mortar, and rusting materials.
- Motor oil, car batteries, and tires.
- Solid waste from industrial processes.
- Leaves, yard clippings, tree and shrub trunks, limbs, and branches.
- Appliances and tires.
- Wet paint cans.
