1. Revised Glen Arden Settlement Agreement

RESOLUTION 79 of 2026

A RESOLUTION ALLOWING THE VILLAGE OF GOSHEN MAYOR TO SIGN THE AMENDED AND RESTATED ASSIGNMENT, ASSUMPTION AND CONSENT AGREEMENT WITH GLEN ARDEN

WHEREAS, an agreement has been prepared for **GLEN ARDEN, INC.**, a New York not-for-profit corporation with an office address of 214 Harriman Drive, Goshen, New York 10924 (**“Assignor”**);

THE KNOLLS AT GOSHEN, INC., a New York not-for-profit corporation with an office address of 2042 Albany Post Road, Suite 8, Croton-on-Hudson, New York 10520 (**“Assignee”**);

ORANGE COUNTY, a municipal corporation with offices at County Office Building, 255 Main Street, Goshen, New York 10924 (**“County”**);

TOWN OF GOSHEN, a municipal corporation with offices at Town Hall, P.O. Box 217, Goshen, New York 10924 (**“Town”**);

VILLAGE OF GOSHEN, a municipal corporation with offices at 276 Main Street, Goshen, New York 10924 (**“Village”**); and

BOARD OF EDUCATION OF THE GOSHEN CENTRAL SCHOOL DISTRICT, a municipal corporation with offices at 229 Main Street, Goshen, New York 10924 (**“School District”**) and, together with the County, the Town and the Village, the **“Taxing Jurisdictions”** and each, individually, a **“Taxing Jurisdiction”**); and

WHEREAS, the Village Board has conducted due diligence on said negotiations and agreement, and discussed with the Village Attorney;

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby

RESOLVED, that the Village of Goshen Mayor is hereby authorized to sign the Amended and Restated Assignment, Assumption and Consent Agreement related to Glen Arden.

2. Grant Writing Proposal for the Water Quality Improvement Program (Goshen Dam)

Correspondence

1. NYS Department of Transportation Route 17M Pavement Preventative Maintenance

Mayor Wohl referenced a June 17, 2026 email stating that the NYS DOT project on NYS Route 17M affecting Monroe, Chester, and Goshen has started.

Mayor, Trustee and Chief Comments

Chief Rich reported that the Goshen High School graduation will take place on Friday, June 26, and the major focus is then on Great American Weekend.

Trustee Kriney asked by New Street and High Street aren't one-way streets. Discussion took place among the board members and all were in agreement to pursue information gathering on the one-way streets.

Trustee Smith shared that she went to the Senior Center monthly meeting, and those present were happy to have someone from the Village Board there.

Trustee Cirigliano Kriney reported on her "Around the Town Comments": she asked if there was anything that could be done with the triangles when coming off the highway at the stop light at Connector Road. As that is a NYS road, permission would need to be granted on beautifying the area. Village Clerk Darby will reach out to contacts she has with NYSDOT for similar triangles the Village has agreements with. Trustee Cirigliano Kriney also discussed the sidewalk on South Church Street that is uneven as there is a tree root lifting the slate.

Mr. Nick Signorelli was at the meeting, and explained that he's a groundskeeper for the Presbyterian Church and he will look into this.

Public Comments

Mr. Nick Signorelli liked the ideas that the board members discussed. He also shared an idea he would see when he lived in New York City, which was opening the fire hydrants to cool people off.

Mr. Jason Pucci of 5 Glen Drive explained that he continues to experience water quality issues, and he has been in touch with DPW, and the hydrants will be flushed, however, it only lasts for three to four weeks. He is looking for a solution, and feels his concerns haven't been follow up on. Additionally, he said that the road quality on Glen Drive is very poor and there are several pot holes.

Mayor Wohl reminding everyone that the Erie Street Ribbon Cutting is scheduled for Friday, July 3 from 12pm – 2pm.

On a motion by Trustee Kriney, seconded by Trustee Smith, the Meeting was adjourned at 8:01 pm.
